

Safety Statement of the Ukrainian Society

ATU

The Ukrainian Society of ATU recognises its responsibility to provide a safe and welcoming environment for all members, participants, and guests. We are committed to safeguarding the health, safety, and wellbeing of everyone involved in our activities and to taking all reasonable steps to prevent accidents and incidents.

Committee Responsibilities

- The President has overall responsibility for health and safety within the Society.
- The Secretary will help oversee safety arrangements and ensure procedures are followed.
- The Treasurer will support safe management of events, particularly where funds or food are involved.

Our Commitments

1. Conduct risk assessments for each event or trip.
2. Use only university- or students' union-approved venues.
3. Follow fire safety rules and venue capacity limits.
4. Ensure proper food hygiene during preparation and serving and clearly label allergens.
5. Provide participants with clear instructions on emergency procedures.
6. Follow university and students' union policies (including alcohol, equality, inclusivity, and respect).
7. Report any incidents or accidents to the Students' Union in line with established procedures.

Member Responsibilities

Members of the Society are expected to:


- Act responsibly and respectfully towards others.
- Follow committee instructions during events.
- Immediately report any unsafe situations or behaviour.

Emergency Procedures

In the event of an emergency, participants should:

1. Follow the instructions of the committee and venue staff.
2. Use emergency exits and gather at designated assembly points.
3. Seek assistance from university security or call emergency services (112) if needed.

This statement will be reviewed annually by the committee and may be updated if activities change or new risks arise.
